House Some maintenance tasks should be done in spring because they help prep your home for the season and the summer to come. Others should be done because spring offers warming temperatures that make it possible to do things that you couldn't do in winter.

- o Clean Gutters
- o Replace HVAC Filter
- o Have HVAC Unit Serviced
- o Check Batteries in Carbon Monoxide and Smoke Detectors
- o Clean Refrigerator Coils
- o Seal Tile Grout
- o Have Septic Tank or Grinder Pump Inspected
- o Clean Dryer Vent
- o Close Fire Place Damper After Last Fire of the Season
- o Check the Caulking Around Windows
- o Get Lawn Equipment Ready; Clean and Sharpen Garden Tools
- o Flush Water Heater
- o Clean Siding of House
- o Clean and Inspect Roof
- o Fix Chipped or Damaged Paint
- o Clean Screen and Windows
- o Trim Vegetation Around Home
- o Get Driveway Seal Coated
- o Look Over Deck and Give It Coat of Stain or Water Repellant
- o Check Attic or Basement for Water Penetration, Water Leaks or Water Stains
